- ✓ Conduct operations in compliance with state and federal environmental legislation and our specific environmental approvals.
- ✓ Communicate with our employees, pastoral stations, regulators, native title groups, business partners and shareholders and consult on our activities throughout the lifecycle of our operations including exploration, mining, processing, closure and rehabilitation.
- ✓ Reduce pollution to mitigate our greenhouse gas footprint and climate change risks to achieve continual improvement of environmental performance.
- ✓ Contribute to biodiversity protection in our areas of operation.
- ✓ Communicate our environmental policy with the team, contractors, joint venture partners and the community.
- ✓ Educate our team members and contractors to ensure environmental responsibility is integrated into work practices, training, risk assessment and decision-making.
